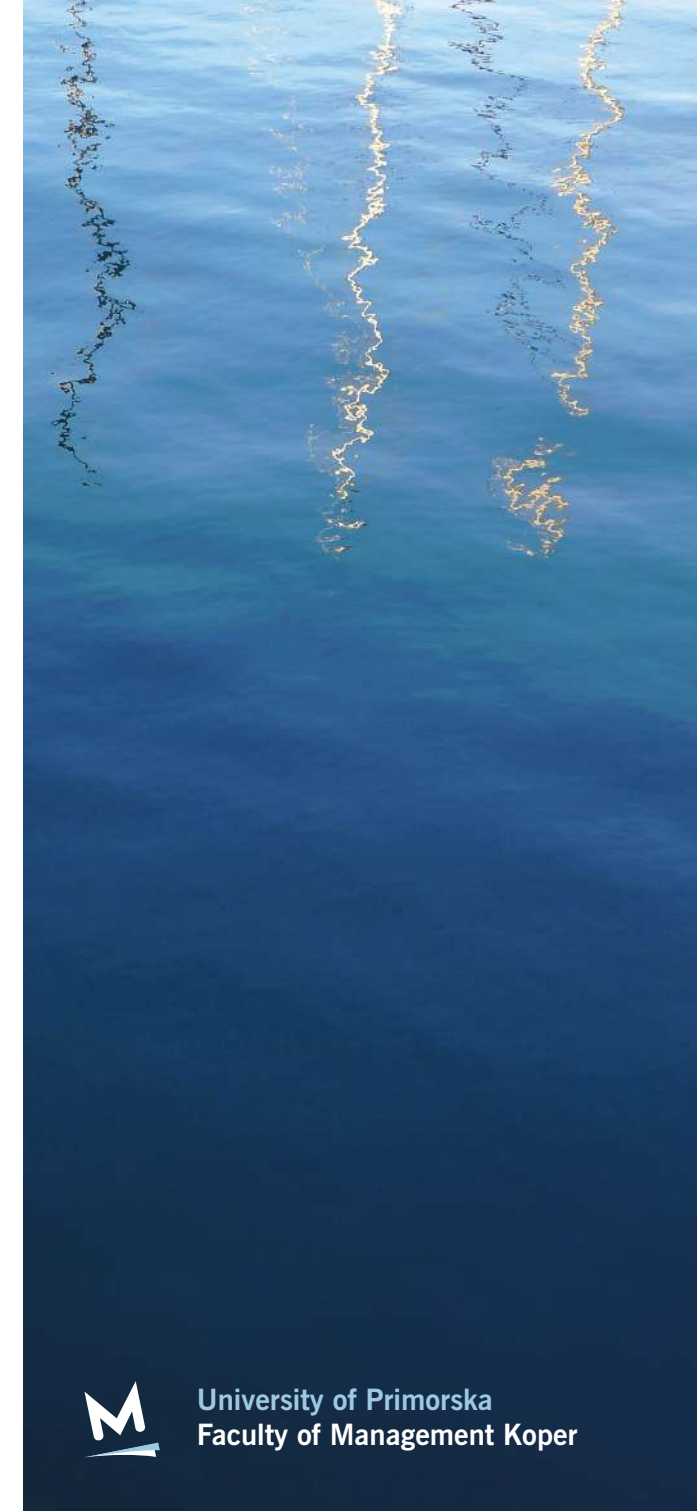

Research

The research activity of the Faculty of Management Koper is closely imbedded in numerous national and international research projects, within the framework of which it cooperates with many domestic and foreign higher education institutes and centres. It also cooperates closely with the economy.

The faculty is carrying out:

- more than 50 research programmes and projects,
- 10 international programmes and projects, and
- more than 15 projects for the economy and other knowledge users.

The research work is an integral part of the activities of higher education lecturers, researchers and associates of the faculty. The faculty also devotes great attention to the research work of students, above all postgraduate students, who take part in scientific research projects, and they can present their achievements each year at the FREM student conference.

The faculty, in cooperation with various institutions, organises a number of scientific seminars, workshops and conferences each year, including the international scientific conference Management International Conference, which takes place each year in a different country.

Publishing House

The publishing house of the Faculty of Management publishes the results of scientific research work of domestic and foreign professionals and various study publications.

It publishes more than 30 new monograph publications annually, of which most are scientific monographs. In addition to scientific monographs and study literature it publishes professional monographs intended for the wider professional public.

Library
